## TRAINING COURSE FOR JUDGES ON COMPETITION LAW The Enforcement of Competition Law in Times of Crisis



Porto Faculty of Law, Universidade Católica Portuguesa is organizing a Training Course for Judges on Competition Law to be held in July 2022. It is funded by the European Commission and supported by CEJ (Centre for Judicial Studies).

Target Audience: Portuguese, Spanish and Polish judges.

Participant selection will be conducted based on inscription order.

#### **Goals:**

Competition law can play a crucial role in times of economic disruption. The stage of recovery after the COVID-19 crisis and the economic recession will only be possible with an adequate enforcement of competition policy. This training course aims to provide national judges with intensive and in-depth training on competition issues, taking into account the latest policies and initiatives of the European Commission and the recent case law of the Court of Justice, representing a significant renewal in EU rules.
